

Parent Agreement: Eastside Family Cooperative

As a member of the Eastside Family Cooperative, I understand and agree to the following:

1. To pay a new family fee (\$130) and monthly dues (\$130).
2. To attend all monthly general meetings on a set day each month (see schedule) from 6:00-7:30pm. If I/we cannot attend the meeting I/we will contact a member of the Executive Committee beforehand and will review the meeting minutes afterward. Our family will provide babysitting during the general meeting, as scheduled, 1-2 times per year and will also provide snack for the meeting as scheduled, 1-2 times per year.
3. To work a weekly 5 hour shift and be available as back-up shift worker four times per quarter. I will arrive for my shift by 8:45 a.m. If I am unable to work my shift, I will be responsible for finding a replacement and notifying the scheduler of the change. As a shift worker, I will strive to maintain a relaxed, loving, creative environment.
4. If I will be working shift, to become certified in Infant/Child CPR & First Aid within 4 weeks of joining Co-op and to provide evidence of certification to the Health & Safety Committee.
5. To contribute 2 hours of committee work per week, per family beyond shift work. I understand that committee work sustains the Co-op, and I am committed to fulfilling this obligation.
6. To clean Co-op, as scheduled, approximately once per quarter (estimated 2 hours per cleaning).
7. To help prioritize for, plan and participate in 2 work parties per year, fundraisers, and similar group activities, which sustain Co-op and foster community.
8. To maintain my membership for a minimum of one year. Should my family fail to honor this commitment, I will pay an additional month's tuition.
9. To provide daily snack for a 2-week period, 2-3 times per year.
10. To maintain my availability in Google Calendar, read all Co-op emails, program the Co-op roster into my phone (and have it with me during shifts) and generally stay connected with the community.

As members of Co-op, we are continually creating, building, envisioning and improving what Co-op is and can be for parents and children in this community. In order for Co-op to run smoothly and successfully and to give all children a positive, rich and supportive experience, all members must give generously of their time, energy, care thought and spirit. We ask you to join our community with this in mind.
